





APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID

- 1 Complete your application for admission with the Admissions Office: (318) 487-7259 | LCUniversity.edu/apply.
- 2 Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov.
Remember your FSA ID and Password! You'll need it again.
- 3 Be sure to add LCU's school code (002007) to your FAFSA.
- 4 Complete the Undergraduate Data Form. This is required of all students each year. This and other required forms can be found on the financial aid form bank at LCUniversity.edu/campus-life/financial-aid/form-bank.
- 5 If you are applying for a student loan, complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN) and the Entrance Loan Counseling online at studentloans.gov.
- 6 Watch your mail and email for updates on the status of your application and requests for additional information.
- 7 Be sure to submit all required documents in a timely manner. Requests are processed in the order they are received.






YOUR FUTURE HOME AWAITS!


Sunrise in Alexandria, Louisiana


